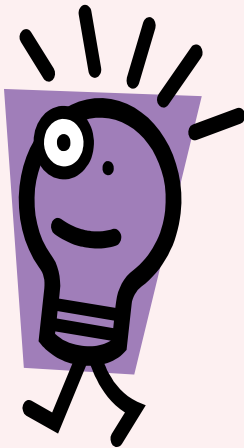
The book will be on display at the 63rd Top of Texas Anniversary held Feb. 13—15, 2009 in Amarillo.

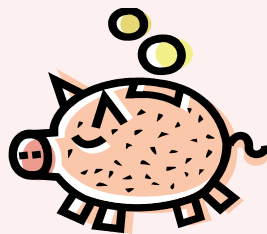
